ATM Equipment Upgrade

This letter is to inform ATM manufacturers that Banking Institutions may be considering a universal alarm device to prevent ATM skimming. Manufactures can help the public perception of better security and reduce identity theft by supporting the dialogue.

The best universal data security improvement has been the update of all ATM and POS to triple encryption (3DES). A possible feature of a universal alarm could be to utilize this communication channel to reduce intrusion by analyzing and updating the alarm in addition to notifying the authorities.
